WITNESS AFFIDAVIT

DAVID E. MINOR

BEFORE ME, A NOTARY PUBLIC, personally appeared Detective William Corser, who being duly sworn says:

Your Affiant is a duly sworn Detective with the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office and is—aware that—DAVID E. MINOR committed a Burglary to an Unoccupied Structure and Tampering with Physical Evidence on or about November 22, 2019, in Pinellas County, Florida.

Your Affiant was assigned a detective and learned about a burglary that occurred at 13001 South Belcher Road, at Belcher Storage, in Largo, Florida, from Unit B23, which belonged to Russel Cruze. Your Affiant is aware that there was surveillance footage that Deputy Melanie Leib viewed together with the victim, Russel Cruz, and the victim identified the individual cutting the lock off of his storage unit and entering as DAVID E. MINOR, an individual he knew personally and had a business relationship with. DAVID E. MINOR can be seen then having two other individuals assist him in loading tools and taking them from the storage unit.

Your Affiant is aware that this storage unit was owned solely by Russel Cruz, that he was the only one with access to it and he was current on his payments to the storage unit which was confirmed by the manager, Natalie Forsberg.

Your Affiant is aware that when surveillance footage was attempted to be downloaded, it had been deleted off of the server. Natalie Forsberg indicated that DAVID E. MINOR had access to the footage as he was part owner of it, and that he deleted the footage.

Your Affiant is also aware that Russel Cruz personally knew that DAVID E. MINOR had installed the security system at this storage facility and that he had a business relationship with them.

And the season of the second file of them. Your Affiant made contact with DAVID E. MINOR and DAVID E. A DESTRUCTION OF SERVICE PROPERTY OF MINOR indicated that his business relationship with Russel Cruz had dissolved and that Russel Cruz was refusing to return his items. He admitted to entering the storage unit to get his items back and claimed receipts as proof and also refused to meet in person to discuss where the items were or any further details about this.

Your Affiant received some documentation from DAVID E. MINOR that appears to be receipts. Your Affiant is aware that these receipts are only for one of the items that was taken, as verified by the victim, but not for the other items taken from the unit.

WHEREFORE, your Affiant respectfully requests the issuance of a Capias so that DAVID E. MINOR may be made to answer to the charges of Burglary to an Unoccupied Structure and Tampering With Physical Evidence.
